Greek and Turkish Language Levels according to CEFR standards

A1.2 - A1 2nd Year - Breakthrough

This course is a follow up from the level A1.1 for students who have basic knowledge of the target language. The student who completes this stage learns greetings, presenting him/herself, numbers, days, basic derivative and non-derivative suffixes, the present continuous and comparing things or people. Also the student can ask and answer simple questions.







Greek and Turkish Language Levels according to CEFR standards

A2.1 - A2 1st year - Elementary

This course is for students who already have the level A1 competency. By the end of the course, the student should be able to understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of most immediate relevance and be able to describe in simple terms aspects of his/her background.

A2.2 - A2 2nd Year - Pre-Intermediate

This course is a follow-up from the 1st year of the A2 level language class. At the end of this level, our students are competent in using present, past and future tenses, noun phrases, main derivative suffixes, noun clauses and a great deal of vocabulary in a fluent way during everyday conversations







Greek and Turkish Language Levels according to CEFR standards

A1.1 - A1 1st year - Complete Beginners

This course is designed for absolute beginners who wish to learn
Turkish/Greek as a foreign language.
By the end of the course, the student will be able to understand some familiar and daily expressions used in very recurring situations.
